INFORMATION ABOUT PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF DATA DURING THE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

(According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR 2016/679)

As of May 25, 2018, the General Regulation on Personal Data Protection (EU) 2016/679, also known as the GDPR, entered into force.

The EU's General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR, replaces Directive 95/46 / EC on data protection and aims to harmonize privacy laws across Europe, with the aim of strengthening the protection of privacy of EU citizens and reforming the way Organizations access private data.

The General Data Protection Regulation applies to the protection of "personal data", which includes any information concerning a person and enables the possibility of identification and directly or indirectly determines elements of his identity. This definition refers to a wide range of personal identification data, which constitute personal data. Such information includes, among other things, the name, the ID number, location data or electronic identifier, which are linked to new technology applications and how organizations, businesses, agencies and professionals collect information about people.

The harmonization of the professionals of the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists with the rules of the GDPR

The Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists is responsible for the processing of your personal data in the context of the submission of the attached consent form.

By submitting the attached consent form, the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists will perform any operation or series of processing acts of your data for the purpose of registration, examination of application and promotion of your personal data.

In this context, it will process any other data that you provide to us in the future, either orally or by any other means, in writing or electronically.

Please read this Information carefully to learn more about how we collect, store, use, transmit and protect the information / personal data we receive.

Please note that both the registration in the Council Register and your personal data

remain as a historical file in the Council and the Registration Council may be able to process your data, where necessary. The processing of your personal data will be based on the express consent that you will provide us at this stage through the attached form or at any other later stage.

Which Personal Data is collected and how

The Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists collects and maintains information concerning both personal and sensitive data. The information collected by the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists includes the following:

- Full Name
- Province
- Address
- Age or date of birth
- Sex
- Telephone number and other contact details as well as email addresses
- Qualifications (Degree, Postgraduate) etc.
- Marital status: Married/Single
- White Penal Code: YES / NO
- Current Vocational Training

The information is collected upon submission of your application for registration with the Registration Board and during the examination or evaluation of your application through meetings with the Registration Board.

Purpose of the collection and processing of Personal Data

The Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists, collects information, which will enable the provision of Speech Therapy and support services to the interested persons. Furthermore, the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists, with the collection of information and meetings, will process the personal data and channel information of the applicants / members to the Ministry of Health, to be published in the Official Gazette of Cyprus, the Cyprus Association of Registered Speech-Language Pathologists and to the RadioMarathon Foundation.

* In case of need to use your personal data, in order to fully practice the profession of Speech-Language Pathologists, the Registration Council may also forward your personal data to any other external bodies. In addition and where deemed necessary, the Registration Board may process your personal information for the completion and approval of your registration in the Register.

Personal Data Security

The Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists is fully compliant with the relevant provisions of the new Regulation on the protection of the individual from the processing of personal data and is committed to protecting your personal data. That is why it takes all necessary measures to ensure that personal data is insured and protected.

All personal data of the interested parties are kept in separate files maintained by the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists within its buildings and are not accessible to third parties.

Please be informed that your personal contact information (telephone, e-mail address, etc.) may be held by secretarial staff for program purposes, meeting arrangements or archiving.

The Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists will process your personal data for as long as your registration lasts and then the files with your personal data will be archived and stored in archives that lock inside the Council buildings.

In case a member is requested to be deleted from the Register of the Council, then the file concerning this member is simultaneously destroyed.

Confidentiality of Information

As mentioned above, the Cyprus Registration Council of Speech-Language Pathologists is committed to protecting and safeguarding the personal data of its applicants / members in accordance with the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data (EU) 2016/679.

However, under the Regulation, the processing of personal data is considered lawful when it is necessary to protect an interest that is essential to the life of the data subject or other natural person. We also inform you that according to the Rules of Ethics of Professional Speech-Language Pathologists the confidentiality of information can be lifted in cases where there is abuse and / or, in case of abuse and neglect of children; in case the client is a serious threat to others and that the person is in danger of harming himself.

What rights do you have regarding the processing of your data:

You have the right to:

- Be informed of the information held by the Registration Board.
- Correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal information.

- Withdraw your consent in whole or in part, at any time for the use of your personal information by the Registration Board.
- Request that your personal information be deleted from the Registration Board.
- Complain to the National Supervisory Authority if you believe that your personal data has been processed illegally.

If you consider that the protection of your personal data is affected in any way, you reserve the right to appeal to the Personal Data Protection Authority.
